The Cypress College **Honors Program Certificate** is designed to encourage talent and ability in highly motivated students as they begin their academic studies and prepare to transfer to a four-year college or university. Students who complete the Honors Program and meet all major transfer requirements will have priority consideration for admission to specific four-year institutions. To earn this certificate, students must apply for and be accepted into the Honors Program, complete the required courses as listed with a minimum grade of "C" and have a minimum 3.0 GPA in all college courses. At least 50% of all course work must be completed at Cypress College. This certificate requires a total of 15 units.
