**PORT 101 F Elementary Portuguese I****5 Units**

90 hours lecture per term. The course focuses on the four major skills of language learning—listening comprehension, speaking, reading and writing—and the grammar and vocabulary necessary to acquire these skills. Included is an introduction to customs, culture, and civilization of Brazil and other Portuguese-speaking countries. This course is conducted primarily in Brazilian Portuguese. Field trips may be required outside of regularly-scheduled class times. Pass/No Pass or Letter Grade option. (Degree Credit) (CSU) (UC) AA GE, CSU GE

**PORT 102 F Elementary Portuguese II****5 Units**

**Prerequisite(s):** PORT 101 F with a grade of C or better or Pass or one year of high school Portuguese with a grade of C or better

90 hours lecture per term. This course continues to focus on the four major skills of language learning—listening comprehension, speaking, reading and writing—and the grammar and vocabulary necessary to acquire these skills. Included is an introduction to customs, culture, and civilization of Brazil and other Portuguese-speaking countries. This course is conducted primarily in Brazilian Portuguese and requires completion of weekly lab assignments. Field trips may be required outside of regularly-scheduled class times. Pass/No Pass or Letter Grade option. (Degree Credit) (CSU) (UC) AA GE, CSU GE, IGETC
