The EOPS Program offers the following services:

- Priority registration
- Orientation to the EOPS Program
- One-on-one over and above academic advising by an EOPS Counselor
- Personalized case management by a Student Services Specialist
- Book Service Award/Lending Library
- Financial Aid and scholarship information
- Tutoring services and workshops
- Transfer assistance and fee waivers
- Outreach and recruitment services
- Special events and activities

Information on Eligibility

The following eligibility criteria apply in order for a student to be considered for the EOPS Program:

- Completed less than 40 units of college level coursework
 - Educationally disadvantaged as determined by the EOPS Program
 - Enrolled full time (12 units) when accepted by the EOPS Program
 - Qualified to receive the California Community College Promise Grant (CCCPG), formerly known as the BOGG Fee Waiver
 - Resident of California or AB540 student
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
